Robert "Scotty" Scott, 68 of Murphysboro, passed away, Thursday, February 7, 2019 in Memorial Hospital of Carbondale.

He was born to Essix Scott and Wilhelmina Fouche in Chicago on March 27, 1950.

Bob married LaDonna Bodkin on January 25, 2006. She preceded him on November 24, 2015.

He had worked for the Jackson County Sheriff's Department from 1972 to 1976. He then began his career at Carbondale Police Department and retired after 30 years of faithful service protecting and serving the county of Jackson as a Lieutenant. He holds the record for the longest employee for the police department. After retirement he worked as security at Southern Illinois Airport.

Bob is survived by his daughter, Amy (Jeff Hawkins) Wilkinson of Alma; grandchildren, Lauren Nottmeier of Carbondale and Nathan Sanford of DuQuoin; many cousins and his 3 beloved Chihuahuas.

He is preceded in death by his beloved wife and his parents.
