Andrew Dean Carpenter, 71, of Murphysboro, passed away at 3:15 p.m. Thursday, June 9, 2016, at his residence in Murphysboro.

Andrew was born on June 23, 1944, in Jackson County, Illinois, to Loren E. Carpenter and Reba (McElmurry) Carpenter.

He had served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam Conflict.

Mr. Carpenter had retired from Twin County Service Company after working as a salesman for thirty nine years.

Andy loved mowing and taking care of his yard and gardening. He enjoyed playing with trains with his grandson, or just spending time with him. He was a chauffeur to Sharon, or in other words, driving "Miss Daisy".
