



Arthur James Faulkner

January 21, 1916 - July 10, 2012

Arthur James Faulkner, 96, of Murphysboro, Illinois, passed away at his residence in Murphysboro, at 9:45 a.m. Tuesday, July 10, 2012.

Gravesite services will be held at 1 p.m. Thursday, July 12, 2012, at Tower Grove Cemetery with military services conducted by the American Legion Post # 127, V.F.W. Posts # 7190 and 2605, and the Jackson County D.A.V. Chapter # 69. Friends may call from 11 a.m. to 12:45 p.m. Thursday at Pettett Funeral Home. Memorials may be made to the Honor Guard.

Arthur was born on January 21, 1916, in Alabama, to Allan Faulkner and Ida (Fowler) Faulkner.

He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II.

In the late 1940's, he moved to work at Lustour, when it opened in Murphysboro, and he retired in 1981 as a printing pressman. He was a member of the International Printing and Graphic Communications Union.

Mr. Faulkner was also a member of the V.F.W. Post # 7190, the American Legion Post # 127, the Murphysboro Senior Citizens, and a lifetime member of the Elks Lodge.

Arthur married Joe Ann Chamberlain on December 18, 1949, in Piggott, Arkansas, and she preceded him in death on April 5, 2007.

He is survived by three children Janet Faulkner and James Faulkner, both of Murphysboro, and Judith (Faulkner) Rose of Akin, IL;

four grandchildren Scott Manis and his wife Mikiko Manis of Olathe, KS, Patricia Rodgers and her husband Bruce Rodgers of Murphysboro, Adam Faulkner and his wife Ashley Faulkner of Herrin, and Emily Faulkner of Akin;

two great grandsons Kane Manis of Olathe, KS and Kyle Wilson of Murphysboro;

and several special nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by three brothers, three sisters and his parents.
