Austin "Bob" P. Attig, 82, of Murphysboro, Illinois, passed away at 11:37 p.m. Wednesday, September 12, 2012, in St. Joseph Memorial Hospital in Murphysboro.

Austin was born on May 1, 1930, in Ladysmith, Wisconsin, to Fred Attig and Velva (Bishop) Attig.

"Bob" was retired from Bemis-formerly Lustour, in Murphysboro, as traffic manager.

Mr. Attig was a member of the Church of the Nazarene in Murphysboro.
