



## Betty Gallick

January 8, 1923 - September 5, 2006

Betty R. Gallick, age 83, of Murphysboro, passed away at 1:04 a.m. Tuesday, September 5, 2006, at St. Vincent Hospital in Indianapolis, Indiana.

Betty was born on January 8, 1923, in Murphysboro, to Ralph H. Bullar and Leta F. (Jennings) Bullar.

She married Lawrence Gallick of West Frankfort, Illinois, on February 17, 1952, in Murphysboro, and he preceded her in death on January 27, 2005.

Mrs. Gallick was employed as a secretary at the Murphysboro Grocery Company and Secretary To The Director of Libraries, Wheeler Library, SIU Carbondale, IL. She was a 50 year member and past worthy matron of the Electa and Ruth chapter of the order of Eastern Star #379 of Murphysboro, and a member of the Past Matron's Club.
