Charles Albert Mann, age 79, of Scottsdale, Arizona, formerly of Murphysboro, passed away at 10:50 p.m. Monday, December 19, 2005, at the Scottsdale Health Care in Scottsdale, AZ.

A funeral mass will be held at 10 a.m. Friday, December 30, 2005, at St. Bruno's Catholic Church in Pinckneyville, with Father Brian Barker and Father Leo Hayes officiating, and burial will be at St. Bruno's Cemetery with military services conducted at the cemetery. Friends may call from 5 to 9 p.m. Thursday at Pettett Funeral Home in Murphysboro, where a prayer service will be held at 7 p.m. Thursday.

Charles was born on July 2, 1926, in Pinckneyville, Illinois, to Bernard Albert Mann and Magdalen Elizabeth (Ruppert) Mann.

He was a World War II Navy veteran.

He was a member of St. Andrew Catholic Church in Murphysboro until February of this year, when he moved to Arizona to live with his daughter Lisa, and then he became a member of St. Bernard's Catholic Church in Arizona. He was a member of the American Legion Post # 127 in Murphysboro.

He had worked at the former Phelps Dodge and former Dunn Concrete, and

he worked as a coal miner before the coal mine closed. Charles enjoyed gardening and hunting in his retirement.

Mr. Mann married Janice E. VanCleave on June 14, 1952, and she preceded him in death in August of 1989. He later married Jo Ellen Brunkhorst in January, 1990, and she preceded him in death in June of 2002.

He is survived by two daughters Lisa A. (Mann) Stanley of Scottsdale, AZ, and Dr. Michelle R. (Mann) Redfearn of Centennial, CO;

one step daughter Janet Bruckhorst Adams and one step son Ralph Brunkhorst , both of Murphysboro;

one brother Joseph Mann of Pinckneyville, IL;
