Charles E. "Sweet Chuck" Crews, 65, of Murphysboro, passed away at 6:32 p.m. on Monday, March 1, 2010, at St. Joseph Memorial Hospital in Murphysboro.

His body has been cremated. Memorial services for Mr. Crews will be held at 7 p.m. on Thursday, March 4, 2010, at Pettett Funeral Home, with Rev. P.K. Sunny officiating. Friends may call from 5 until the hour of service at 7 p.m. In lieu of flowers, it is the family's request that memorials may be made to the American Cancer Society or the American Heart Association.

Charles was born April 13, 1944, in Elkhart, Illinois, to Henry Scott Crews and Maggie (DeLena) Crews.

Mr. Crews was a plumber and pipefitter for Honeywell for 40 years. He was a member of the Plumber and Pipefitter Local #160 in Murphysboro.

Charles served in the National Guard.

He was also a member of the Elks and the American Legion Post #127. He also was a member of the Jackson County Country Club.

Chuck married Priscella (Graul) Crews May 25, 1968, in DuQuoin, Illinois, and

she survives.

and one sister and three brothers Warren Crews of Atlanta, Georgia, Donald Crews of Peoria, Illinois, Jerry Crews of Murphysboro, and Nancy Petry of Ellisville, Missouri;
