Charles E. Endres, 88, of Murphysboro, passed away at 3:30 p.m. Monday, July 12, 2010, at St. Joseph Memorial Hospital in Murphysboro, Illinois.

A Funeral Mass will be held at 10 a.m. Friday, July 16, 2010, at St. Andrew Catholic Church with Father Gary Gummersheimer and Father James Buerster officiating and burial will be at Murdale Gardens of Memory with military services conducted by the American Legion Post # 127, V.F.W.
