Charles H. Piquard, age 83, of Murphysboro, passed away at 1:08 a.m. Thursday, November 9, 2006, at Memorial Hospital in Carbondale. Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Monday, November 13, 2006, at Pettett Funeral Home with Rev. Andrew Mifflin officiating and burial at Tower Grove Cemetery with military services conducted by the American Legion Post # 127, V.F.W. Post # 7190 and 2605, and the Jackson County D.A.V.
