Charles M. "Mike" Naegele, 65, of Murphysboro, passed away at 7 p.m. Wednesday, July 23, 2014, in the Memorial Hospital of Carbondale.

Charles M. was born on December 24, 1948, in Murphysboro, to Charles and Anna (Reeves) Naegele.

Mr. Naegele served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam Conflict from 1969 to 1971.

He had worked for Arch Mineral Captain Mines for twenty years and the retired from SIUC Grounds Department in 2011.
