Chester F. Dunivan, age 92, of Murphysboro, passed away at 6:55 p.m. Sunday, September 19, 2010, at the Carbondale Rehab and Care Center, Carbondale, Illinois.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Wednesday, September 22, 2010, at Pettett Funeral Home with Rev. Larry Gilbert officiating with burial at Tower Grove Cemetery. Friends may call from 5 to 8 p.m. Tuesday and Wednesday until 11 a.m. at the funeral home.

Chester was born on August 27, 1918, in Vergennes, Illinois, to Claude Dunivan and Hettie (Finney) Dunivan Bleihle.
