Clarence D. Pulcher, 88, of Murphysboro, passed away at 8:30 p.m. Thursday, July 17, 2014, in the Rehab and Care Center of Jackson County, Murphysboro.

Clarence was born on February 20, 1926, in East Carondelet, Illinois, to Alfred Pulcher and Ruth (Graff) Pulcher.

He served in the U.S. Marine Corps during WW II. He served in the Pacific Theater serving at Saipan on the Marianas Islands, and Okinawa on Ryukyu Islands.

Both Mr. Pulcher and his wife Mildred worked as custodians for St. Andrew School for many years. They were dearly loved by the students and teachers at the school.

Clarence has a farmer, but he also had worked as a plasterer at the former Troutt Plasterers in Carbondale until his retirement. He was a member of the Laborer's Union Local # 227 for sixty years.

Mr. Pulcher was a member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Murphysboro. He was also a member of the American Legion Post # 127 and the V.F.W. Post # 7190 in Murphysboro.

He married Mildred Bradshaw on April 21, 1946, and she just passed away on July 3, 2014, after sixty-eight years of marriage.

Clarence is survived by four children and their spouses David and Ruby Pulcher of Murphysboro, Esther and Fred Phoenix of Ava, Janet and David Stein, and Donna and Dennis Johnson, all of Murphysboro;

ten grandchildren and fifteen great grandchildren;
