Clifford L. "Dude" Seibel, 88, of Murphysboro, Illinois, passed away at 12:59 p.m. Wednesday, October 5, 2011, at Memorial Hospital in Carbondale, Illinois.

Clifford was born on September 24, 1923, in Murphysboro, Illinois, to Arthur Seibel and Ethel (Hunter) Seibel.

He served forty months in the U.S. Coast Guard during World War II, and he served in the American, Middle East, and South Pacific Theaters of War.

He was engaged in farming, he raised and showed Quarter Horses, and he worked for Bost Trucking. He also was an engineer for the Illinois Central Railroad for thirty five years.

Mr. Seibel was a member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Murphysboro. He was a member of the American Legion Post # 127 and the V.F.W. Post # 7190, and the Jackson County Farm Bureau, all of Murphysboro.

Cliff married JoAnne Baird on May 1, 1954, in Murphysboro, and she preceded him in death on August 10, 1975.
