Craig M. Burton passed on to God's greater glory at 5:02 am June 22, 2019 at the young age of 65.

Craig was born in Christopher to Thomas Maurice Burton and Jeraldine Mae (Travelstead) Craig and was a brother to Mark, Sandra Jean and Gary Burton.

Craig was married to Marlina (Thomas) Burton for 30 years and best friends for 37 years. Craig had one son from a previous marriage, Cullen M (Jonelle) and one granddaughter, Aleah of Omaha, NE. He loved his in-laws, Ronald and Julia Thomas as if they were his parents. The family welcomed him with love and hugs of which he was not too fond of, but became a hugger in time.

Craig had many talents, he played the accordion, even with his right index finger being partially amputated, was a ferrier, blacksmith, EMT, and retired recently as a Registered Respiratory Therapist. He LOVED the science behind guns, was a gun enthusiast and shared gun reviews with many. He enjoyed driving Marlina on back roads, and always had to take a "new" road each ride. He loved and enjoyed seeing the beauty of nature and often said "We are so rich, God's country is so amazing."

He renewed his relationship with Jesus 21 years ago and was known for sharing God's goodness. He was a true worshipper and praised God

regardless of where he was. He so loved the services at First Apostolic Church in Centralia. Prior to leaving this earth on his last day, he witnessed to three hospital staff and told them how God answered his plea for pain control immediately.

Craig was often told he missed his calling as a comedian, so if you have funny stories to share, we would love to hear them. Marlena always told Craig: "Laughter is the best medicine, you keep me laughing, you are so good for my health, and you keep me praying."

Craig is survived by his loving wife Marlena; his son, Cullen (Jonelle) Burton, a granddaughter, Aleah of Omaha, NE; cherished nieces and nephews, in-laws, Ronald and Julia Thomas; other relatives and a host of friends.

Craig was preceded in death by his parents, all three siblings, maternal Grandparents, John & Lela Travelstead, and paternal grandparents, Sanford and Daisy Burton.

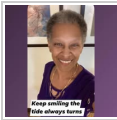

The service was peaceful and comforting, of course we had some laughs as that was the way Craig was.

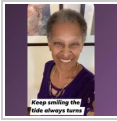
Yes we were all shocked, he passed a day before his Mom passed 11 years ago. Imagine the family reunion they must be having. God bless you and your family.
