Cynthia Good, age 74 of Murphysboro formerly of French Town, New Jersey, passed away on Saturday, December 19, 2015 in Manor Court of Carbondale.

She was born October 14, 1941 to Charles and Ida (Berndt) Good in Detroit, Michigan.

Cynthia was an undergraduate and received her masters at New York University. She attended law school at St. John's University and was an attorney for the State of New Jersey, Office of the State Guardian. She was also an attorney for the U.S. Army at Picatinny Arsenal in New Jersey, where she retired. She had represented the United States in International Equestrian Competition. She was instrumental in getting 503 & 504 Rehabilitation Act of 1973 for access for the disabled.

She is survived by her sisters, Kathy Chonez of Murphysboro; Lylas Mogk, MD of Grosse Pointe Park, MI; and Wendy Kindred of Portland, Maine, nieces, nephews, other relatives and many friends.

She was preceded in death by her parents.
