Daniel Allen Seegers, age 75 of Murphysboro, passed away Saturday, September 7, 2024 at Memorial Hospital in Carbondale.

Dan was born on March 25, 1949 to Willard and LaVera (Dettmer) Seegers in Denver, Iowa. He grew up on a farm and was the third of five children. He is survived by his sister, Paulette (David) Daniels, and his brother, Michael (Jody) Seegers. He is also survived by the love of his life and best friend, Jodi Seegers (Wright) who he married July 27, 1968.
