



Reverend Daryl M. Winn

August 10, 1949 - April 21, 2021

Rev. Daryl M. Winn, age 71, of Herrin, formerly of Marion, passed away on Wednesday, April 21, 2021 at 11:00 a.m. at the VA Medical Center Community Living Center in Marion.

Rev. Winn was born on August 10, 1949 in Holden Hospital in Carbondale, Illinois, a son of Max E. and Dorothy J. (Armes) Winn. He married Lucinda K. Hutchison on July 19, 1969 and she survives. Daryl worked for 19 years as a correctional officer for the Vienna Correctional Center. After retiring from the Illinois Department of Corrections he worked for B.A.R.T. Transport. Rev. Winn was an ordained minister, having pastored for a time and loved to share the message of Jesus with all he came in contact with. He proudly served his country in the United States Air Force, having served in Vietnam from 1970 – 1971. Daryl also loved fishing, riding motorcycles, the beach, and spending time with his wife, Lucinda.

Survivors include his loving wife of nearly 52 years, Lucinda K. Winn of Herrin; sisters-in-law, Janice Davis of Energy and Sara (Mark) Emery of Herrin; brother-in-law, Charles (Anna) Hutchison of Houston, Texas; niece, Lindsay (Aaron) Campbell; nephew, Charles Cody Hutchison; two great-nieces, Ashton Oakley and Halle Campbell; a great-nephew, Wyatt Oakley; several cousins; and many friends.

He was preceded in death by his grandparents; parents, Max and Dorothy Winn; and his brother, Scott Winn.
