Deloris loved her grandchildren, Xayvion, Nailah and Amaya with all of her heart. Deloris served as her immediate family's matriarch. She loved celebrating birthdays and holidays. She was well respected no matter the circumstances and was known to keep family together.

Deloris loved children and would take any child in need, families as well. She ran an in-home daycare where she cared for children of friends and family. People always said it didn't matter what was going on, she always was willing to be with the children, when confronted with this she replied "I got one life to make memories, I'm gonna make mine."

Deloris married Delbert Hall on Thursday September 11, 2008. Today would have been their 16th anniversary.
