Dr. Clide DeWayne Cassity, age 76, of Palmetto, Florida passed away peacefully, Saturday, November 4, 2017.

He was born August 20, 1941 in Browning, Missouri, to Cecil and Lois Cassity. Clide was one of five children. Clide was a longtime member of the First Baptist Church in Bradenton, Florida.
