Edward "Ed" Koenig, age 73, of Murphysboro, passed away at 6:04 p.m. Sunday, November 5, 2006, at St. Joseph Memorial Hospital in Murphysboro.

Edward was born on March 13, 1933, in Murphysboro, to Edward L. Koenig and Catherine (Gillooly) Koenig.

He was a U.S. Army veteran of the Korean Conflict.

Mr. Keonig was an accountant, and a member of St. Andrew Catholic Church, where he had been a former trustee of the church and a past member of the St. Andrew Parish Council. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus Council # 988, a past Grand Knight, and a 4th degree Knight.

He loved baseball and was an avid Cardinal fan, and he managed the American Legion and Red Wings Baseball Team, as well as Little League Team.

Ed married Shirley Smith on February 11, 1961, in Murphysboro and she survives.
