



## Edward L. "Eddie" Strothmann

July 16, 1930 - December 8, 2020

Edward "Eddie" L. Strothmann, age 90, of Murphysboro, passed away at 5:23 p.m. Tuesday, December 8, 2020, at The Voyage in Marion, Illinois.

Edward was born on July 16, 1930, in Murphysboro, Illinois, to Henry and Rose (Ziegler) Strothmann.

He served in the U.S. Army, and was a lifetime member of the Paul Stout American Legion Post # 127 in Murphysboro.

Mr. Strothmann was a member of Our Savior Lutheran Church in Carbondale, Illinois.

Eddie and his wife Sharon were the former co-owners of Murdale Gardens of Memory in Murphysboro. His hobby was working. He was still trying to clean and plant grass at the nursing home.
