Elanor (Stuart) Farris, 87, of Goreville, formerly of Olive Branch, passed away at 4:55 AM, Tuesday, November 10, 2020 at Angel Acres in Marion.

She was born June 29, 1933 in Alexander County, Illinois to Claude and Greta (Billings) Stuart. She married Ted Farris on October 29, 1950. He preceded her in death on May 28, 1998.
