Elmer C. Rogers, age 88, of Makanda, passed away at 8:42 p.m. Friday, March 23, 2007, at the Illinois Veteran's Home in Anna.

Elmer was born on March 2, 1919, in Corning, Arkansas, to Silas Rogers and Clara (Stagner) Rogers.

He was a World War II Navy veteran, and after his return from the war, he was a resident of Union and Jackson Counties.

Mr. Rogers was a lifetime member of the V.F.W. Post # 3455 in Anna.
