Elsie Mae Boston, age 85, formerly of Murphysboro, passed away at 12:10 a.m. Monday, October 24, 2005, at the Missouri Baptist Hospital, St. Louis, MO.

Mae was born on February 24, 1920, in Whitley Bay, England, to Francis Spindloe and Emily (Pengilley) Spindloe.

Mrs. Boston had most recently worked as the head cook at McElvain School and had worked a total of seventeen years as a cook in the school district. She and her husband had previously owned an apartment house, and she had also worked at Selmier Peerles and at the Jacket Factory.

She had been a member of the former Epworth Methodist Church and presently was a member of the United Methodist Church in Murphysboro.

She married to Leroy Boston in 1940 and he preceded her in death on February 22, 1975.
