Floyd Eugene McMannis, age 92, of Murphysboro, passed away on Saturday, March 28, 2026 at Memorial Hospital in Carbondale, Illinois.

He was born on August 8, 1933 to Walter and Ruby (Reames) McMannis in Sand Ridge, Illinois. On January 28, 1967, he married Jean (Reiman) McMannis.

Floyd graduated from Gorham High School in 1951 and entered the United States Air Force, where he proudly served in Florida and Africa. He retired from Curwood after 47 years followed by many happy years of enjoying time with family and friends. Floyd spent decades with friends at the American Legion Post 127, having held the financial officer position, served with the Color Guard, and volunteered weekly with Bingo and the Queen of Hearts.
