



## Ford L. Frick

June 10, 1938 - December 8, 2009

Ford L. Frick, 71, of Murphysboro, Illinois, died at 4:35 p.m. Tuesday, December 8, 2009, at Rehab and Care Center of Jackson County in Murphysboro.

Funeral services will be at 11 a.m. Friday, December 11, 2009, at Pettett Funeral Home in Murphysboro, with Rev. Alan Rhein officiating, and burial will be at Pleasant Hill Cemetery in Murphysboro. Friends may call from 5 to 8 p.m. Thursday and Friday until 11 a.m. at the funeral home. Masonic Services will be held at 7 p.m. Thursday at the funeral home. Ford was born June 10, 1938, in Jonesboro, Illinois, to Ford Frick and Juanita (Phelps) Frick.

He was a TV technician.

Mr. Frick was a mason in the A. F. and A. M. Masonic Lodge in Makanda, Illinois.

But he was well known for playing the bass and singing in the Ron and the Bossman Band from 1950 through the early 1990's, They performed from Chicago to Southern Illinois and the band recorded four singles at Mercury

Studios in Nashville, Tennessee. Ford played with many famous people including Charlie Pride, Charlie Rich, and Carl Perkins.

Ford married Marilyn Herd on November 30, 1995, in Jonesboro, and she survives.

Other survivors include six children Shadi Frick and his wife Karen Frick and Jennifer Corpus and her husband Jason Corpus, all of Carbondale, Wade Frick, Eric Trisler of Jerseyville, IL, Monty Trisler, and Annette Kennon;

two stepchildren John Keller and his wife Debbie Keller, and Barbara Keller, all of Murphysboro;

several grandchildren including Lexi Frick of Carbondale and Jenna Keller of Murphysboro;

one brother Ronald Frick of Anna;

one sister Joyce Braswell and her husband Marvin Braswell of Carbondale;

and one half sister Mary Jane Thompson.

He was preceded in death by his parents.
