February 1, 1936 - December 2, 2020

At 84 years old and in the worst global pandemic, our dad chose to help his community, serve and heal, fight in the frontlines. No one could convince him to retire, especially not when the community he loved needed him most. Ultimately, he died doing what he loved. Covid took an amazing man, husband, father, and grandfather.

Married to his true love, Dialina Wong, on Nov. 21st, 1970. She was his sun, he was her air. They were made for each other. Soon after, Patrick, Kirk, Gemo Jr. and Christy were born and completed the Wong dynasty of Cairo, IL.

My dad was known as doctor to the community of Southern IL. He dedicated his life to serving and healing its people for almost 50 years. He worked to make sure he provided for his family, but primarily he worked because he knew that people needed him. He was selfless when it came to caring for others. His passion was truly providing....providing answers and providing hope to his patients. And although he was a very skilled physician, his greatest trait was his compassion. His compassion allowed him to connect with his patients in a lasting manner. This compassion is why every patient and co-worker are so affected by this loss.

Despite many other job opportunities over the years, my dad never left Cairo. My dad and Cairo formed a special bond, he truly loved that community and

its people. He faithfully served generations of its citizens and took pride in doing so. They, in turn, loved him back as evident by the overwhelming outpouring of love and support.

We lost a great man, husband, father, and grandfather. He selflessly gave so much to his community and his family, finding strength and inspiration from the people around him. Being a parent now, I'm not sure I could ever accomplish what he did in two lifetimes.

I've always said if there were more Gemo Wong's in the world, it would be a better place. But, I've come to realize there is no chance of that happening because he was unique, truly one-of-a-kind. No other person can ever be what he meant to those that knew him.

“ I shall never forget the day that I met this wonderful gentleman, Gemo Wong, M.D., on a frozen Valentine's Day evening, February 14, 1984, on my way to meet with administrators at Massac County Hospital to explore a job opportunity post Fellowship completion as part of a way to forgive some of the immense debt I had acquired in medical school. At the time, and likely now as well, Saline, Pope, Hardin and Alexander Counties were considered medically underserved.

I honestly cannot recall how I ended up in Cairo that evening but I did. I was basically stuck there and ended up in a restaurant called the "Leevee" I believe. The bartender that cold, blustery evening looked as if he had not bathed for some time and a very ectomorphic waitress who was yelling at a patron named "Slim" quashed any appetite I may have had for food, drink and/or parenteral nutrition of any kind.

These facts notwithstanding, I was stuck there with nowhere else to go. About 20 minutes later, in walked a very engergetic Asian gentleman who, it turned out, was Doctor Wong. Immediately the mojo of the entire restaurant changed. It was as if St John the Baptist, hair shirt and all, entered to undue the sandal straps of one greater than he. That, however, was not the case because the Son of God himself, or so it appeared to me, had entered the building. His name was Gemo Wong, M.D.

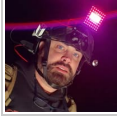
He and I ended up discussing a plethora of issues about which I still think. He told me about Shawnee National Forest and how much he enjoyed going there with his family. He spoke of emergent changes in medicine and the hardships, yet joys, of practicing in a town like Cairo. He indicated that some of his patients, too poor to pay him with pecuinary, offered chickens, St. Louis Cardinals tickets and other bartered goods as a means to make him whole for the wonderful care he provided.

After losing myself in the many yarns that Doctor Wong spun, I

looked at my watch and realized it was almost 9PM, much too late for a city slicker like me, from Dundas, IL, originally but freshly minted from an interventional radiology fellowship at the University of Michigan, to be up. I politely bid the good Doctor Wong a sincere "good night" when in walked this absolutely amazing woman. I had no idea "what" she was doing there at that time but intended to find out. To make a very long story short, Doctor Wong knew this beautiful goddess who was visiting nearby Carbondale where she was supposed to play the Sibelius Opus 47 violin concerto with the school's symphonic orchestra the next day. Her name was Veronica and she was originally from Venezuela. Doctor Wong had treated her. five years earlier, I learned, for a Lisfranc fracture of her left foot. As luck would have it, this woman was studying at Julliard and I was never to see her again but the joy and relaxation I received, in her presence that one evening for about 75 minutes, far exceeded anything I had theretofore experienced the entire previous year. If, in fact, she had recommended my procurement of pork fritters and cheese doodles from the previously described waitress and implored me to eat it off of the bathroom floor, I would have complied. Truth be told, Veronica left me her phone number, written on back of a receipt from a McDonald's I visited, earlier that day, in Paducah, KY, which I promptly lost, I believe, while trying to get into much too small Dodge Omni auto that I had rented for the pilgrimage to Mecca. That, and refraining to invest regularly in Sun Microsystems and a good orthodontist, are perhaps my two biggest regrets to date.

Anyway, when I learned of this great healer's death I thought immediately back to that Tuesday evening so long ago and the immense debt of gratitude this poor, tired town of Cairo, and others in its vicinity, owe this amazing individual. Every now and again, God sends us angels whose move us in ways previously unknown. Gemo Wong, rest in peace.

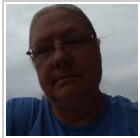

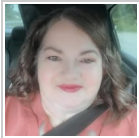
