Glenn Jennings, 71, of Murphysboro, Illinois, passed away at 3:15 a.m. Monday, October 8, 2012, at the Relais Bonne Eau Hospice House in Edwardsville, Illinois.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Friday, October 12, 2012, at Pettett Funeral Home with Rev. Ken Staib officiating and burial at Pleasant Grove Memorial Park.
