Herbert Lee Shelton, 89, of Carbondale, Illinois, passed away at 8:20 p.m. on Sunday, November 13, 2011, at the Rehab and Care Center of Jackson County in Murphysboro, Illinois.

Herbert was born January 1, 1922, in Eldorado, Illinois, to John Shelton and Lora Ellen (Little) Shelton.

Mr. Shelton served in the U.S. Army Air Corps during World War II.

He owned and operated Shelton TV Service, in Carbondale, from 1958 to 2006.

Mr. Shelton was a member of the First Church of God in Carbondale. He had a radio show on WXAN, called "International Sunday School Lesson", from 2005 to 2008. He also served on the City of Carbondale Water Department Board for many years.

Herbert married Mary E. Shelton on September 28, 1946, in Murphysboro, and she preceded him in death on February 1, 2010.
