He was rather tight with his finances and he could make the buffalo bark on a nickel at times. Those in the family that knew him knows that is a common point of laughter in the family.

Hooter was never married, but came from a large family. He had four brothers; Alvin, Roger, Rusby and Michael, and four sisters; Celeste, Vicki, Virginia and Donna, all of whom have preceded him in death. So he is the last of the Rudluff Mohicans in that generation. He is survived by numerous Nieces and Nephews and grand Nieces and Nephews and will always hold a special place in our hearts.
