



Imogene Gollither LaPlant

January 19, 1917 - April 13, 2010

Imogene Gollither-LaPlant, 93, of Murphysboro, passed away at 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday, April 13, 2010, at her residence in Murphysboro.

Funeral services for Mrs. LaPlant will be held at 11 a.m. Friday, April 16, 2010, at the First Presbyterian Church in Murphysboro, with Rev. Charles W. Walden officiating and burial at Pleasant Grove Memorial Park in Murphysboro. Friends may call from 9 a.m. until the hour of service at the church. Imogene was born January 19, 1917, in Murphysboro, to Hugh Reeder and Ruth (Bullar) Reeder.

She was a retired topstitcher at the former Brown Shoe Factory in Murphysboro.

Mrs. LaPlant was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Murphysboro, and she was a member of the American Legion Post # 127 Ladies Auxiliary, VFW Post # 7190 Ladies Auxiliary, Jackson County # 40 and # 8, Jackson County Home Extension, St. Joseph Hospital Auxiliary, Rehab and Care Center Auxiliary, and Jackson County Historical Society.

Imogene married John Gollither on March 25, 1943, in Pinckneyville, Illinois, and he preceded her in death on December 26, 1954. She married Chad LaPlant on December 19, 1965, in Murphysboro, and he preceded her in death on February 23, 1993.
