"Railroad Jack" Ebersohl, age 66, of Murphysboro, passed away at 3:14 p.m. Thursday, May 14, 2020, at his sister's residence in Murphysboro.

Jack was born on January 5, 1954, in Murphysboro, Illinois, to Delbert and Imogene (Casey) Ebersohl.

In his younger years, he had worked as a landscaper. Then he worked for twenty years for the I.C.G. Railroad-Union Pacific, and more recently he had worked for the Murphysboro Police Department.
