Jackie L. Layne, age 78, of Mason, Michigan and formerly of Campbell Hill area, passed away at 7:45 a.m. Friday, January 1, 2010, at the Hospice of Lansing in Lansing, Michigan.

moved to Mason, Michigan.

Mr. Layne worked for 30 years for the U.S. Steel Corporation, then 11 years with the Waukegan Police Department Auxiliary, and then for four years with the Waukegan Public Schools.

Jackie loved music and he loved to garden, watch movies, pitch horse shoes, golf, fish, and hunt.

Mr. Layne was married most of his life and he is survived by three children Adam Layne and his wife Kandra Layne of Leslie, Michigan, Victor Layne of Waukegan, IL, and Jackie Layne, Jr.;

three grandchildren Felicia Layne and Adam Layne of Illinois, and John Czarnicki of California;

three great grandchildren;

two sisters Arscele Reiman and her husband Wayne Reiman of Murphysboro and Venita Bansemer of Jacksonville, FL;

one sister in law Florence Layne of IL;
