James C. Dismore, 92, of Mounds, IL died at 12:38 PM Friday, October 10, 2014 at Memorial Hospital of Carbondale.

He was born September 1, 1922 in East Prairie, Missouri to Luther Emmet and Anna Lee Wiles Dismore. He was married to Tamara Rundles-Dismore and was of the Baptist faith.

Mr. Dismore was a highly decorated veteran of World War II, having landed on Normandy Beach during the Invasion and fought all the way to Germany.
