James Daniel “Bubby” Wallace, age 79, of Cape Girardeau, Missouri, passed away on October 16, 2020 at 2:01 a.m. at St. Francis Medical Center.

Jim was born on April 15, 1941 in Malden, Missouri, a son of Marvin and Ida (Oliver) Wallace. He was a proud veteran of the United States Navy having served alongside his brother, Don, on the USS Muliphen (AKA 61) from 1961-1963 during the Cuban Missile Crisis.
