Jerry Marvin Bennett, age 63, of Thebes, Illinois, passed away on Thursday, November 14, 2024 at Barnes-Jewish Hospital in St. Louis, Missouri.

Jerry was born August 5, 1961 to Marvin and Donna (Baugher) Bennett in Cape Girardeau, Missouri. He married Lori Koch on October 8, 1999 and together have spent over 25 years together and she survives.

During his law enforcement career of 40 + years, he worked for Thebes as the Marshall, the Cairo Police Department, Pulaski County Sheriff's Office, and was assigned to the Illinois Drug Task Force as an Inspector of The Illinois State Police. He was hired by the Federal Bureau of Investigations for the Drug Task Force and participated in Operation "River City Crack Out" and was sworn in as a Special Federal Officer. He then went to work for the Alexander County Sheriff's Department where he earned rank of Chief Deputy. Jerry was always quick witted with a great sense of humor and loved to laugh. He was

loyal and had a heart of gold and was a very generous person. In his spare time, he was a member of the Knights Templar. He loved and enjoyed all kinds of music and was a talented guitar player. As well, he enjoyed collecting antique pocket watches, fire trucks and guitars. He loved the Lord and enjoyed studying the Bible.
