Joseph Wesley Higgerson, Jr., 94, formerly of Rockwood and Dupo, passed away at 4:30 a.m. Sunday, November 23, 2014, at the Helia Health Care of Greenville in Greenville, Illinois.

Joseph was born on February 24, 1920, in Kinkaid Township, Illinois, to Joseph Wesley Higgerson, Sr. and Effie Ellen (Slusher) Higgerson.
