



Joseph "Joe" Schram

April 8, 1942 - April 20, 2021

Joseph "Joe" Schram, 79, of Scott City, passed away at 6:13pm Tuesday, Apr. 20, 2021 at his home.

He was born Apr. 8, 1942 in Oran, the son of Albert Adam and Clara Theresa (Ziegler) Schram.

Joe was a brakeman and conductor for Frisco-Santa Fe and later Burlington Northern Railroad in Chaffee, retiring after 30 years of service. He also farmed his whole life.

He was a member of the St. Augustine Church of Kelso and a 54 year member of the Elks in Chaffee. He was a commissioner for the Illmo Special Road District, volunteered with his wife for Girl Scouts, and was baseball manager of the Benton leagues.

Survivors include his wife, Mary Jane, and granddaughter, Jessica Lynn, several cousins and many friends.

Besides his parents he was preceded in death by a brother, Jim Schram.
