June Alene (Riggs) Truhn, 87, of Murphysboro, passed away at 9:31 p.m. Thursday, February 25, 2010, at the Crossroads Community Hospital in Mt. Vernon, Illinois.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Monday, March 1, 2010, at Pettett Funeral Home with Rev. Larry Gilbert and Rev. Earl Renshaw officiating with burial at Pleasant Grove Memorial Park with military services conducted by the American Legion Post # 127, V.F.W. Post # 7190 and 2605, and the Jackson County D.A.V. She married Marvin Truhn on October 22, 1946, in Chicago, Illinois, and he preceded her in death on December 19, 1987.

Mrs. Truhn retired as an underwriting specialist for State Farm Insurance, where she worked for forty years in St. Paul, Minnesota.

June returned to Murphysboro, in October of 1986.

She was a member of the United Methodist Church in Murphysboro, the Association for Research and Enlightenment, the Garden Club of Ramsey County, Minnesota, North American Lily Society, American Legion Auxillary, Murphysboro Senior Citizen, North Star Lily Society, Iowa Lily Society, and the Wisconsin Lily Society.
