Kenneth "Dale" Pulcher, 68, of Murphysboro, passed away at 3 p.m. Sunday, December 23, 2012, at his residence in Murphysboro, Illinois.

Kenneth was born on February 9, 1944, in Carbondale, Illinois, to Gilbert W. Pulcher and Georgia Aleen (Winget) Pulcher.

He served in the U.S. Army.

Dale was a retired plumber and had worked at SIU-C.
