January 3, 1924 - September 7, 2015

Lenora June "June" Williams, nee Sickler, 91, of Murphysboro, born January 3, 1924, in Sandridge, Illinois, died Monday, September 7, 2015. She died at home surrounded by her family and her beloved dog. Sockie.

Mrs. Williams graduated from Murphysboro Township High School in 1943, and immediately moved to St. Louis to work as a riveter at Curtis-Wright Aviation. She joined the WAVES, an all-female branch of the U.S. Navy in February, 1944, and was honorably discharged in November, 1946. She also attended Southern Illinois University.

June was a long time member of Faith United Methodist Church of Vergennes, Illinois, and a former volunteer of St. Joseph Memorial Hospital Auxiliary. She was a loving mother and grandmother, an avid fisherman and loved sewing, quilting and embroidery.

Preceding her in death was her first husband, Andrew J. Tuck of Pensacola, FL, a pilot in the U.S Navy; her second husband, Glenn D. Williams, a businessman in Murphysboro; her parents Charles Carrel and Edith Grace Sickler; and a son in law Raymond L. Rodriguez.
