Lester H. Cramer, 90, passed away peacefully after a short illness on Saturday, March 11, 2023.

He was born on April 21, 1932 in Centralia, IL to the late Arthur and Emma (Heseman) Cramer. He married Loraine Rebstock on August 15, 1954 and she survives. They shared over 68 wonderful years of marriage.

Les graduated from Centralia High School. After a year at Concordia Lutheran College, Concordia, MO, and a year at Southern Illinois University, Carbondale, he joined the Army in 1953, serving until 1956. After his military service, he attended the Vocational Technical Institute of SIUC, graduating with an Associates Degree in Mechanical Drafting. While at VTI, he worked part-time at the SIU print shop as a proof reader and cameraman. After graduation, he began a full-time career with the University, eventually becoming the manager of the print shop. Before retirement, he served the University in several capacities, including a time with Auxiliary Enterprises and retiring as the Associate Director of University Graphics and Publications.

Les and Loraine enjoyed several trips and cruises with close friends over the years. They visited Germany, the Rivers of Europe, Canada and cruised through the Panama Canal. Les' loves included his faith and church, his family, fishing, bowling and wood working.

Lester is survived by his wife, Loraine of Murphysboro and their sons of Murphysboro, Bryce (Janet), and Bryan (Kim); grandchildren Shaun (Jen Fyke) of New Lenox, Amanda (Trenten Kessler) of University City, Mo, and Tony (Michelle) of Carterville; three great-grandchildren; sister-in-law Minnette Cramer of Hoyleton, IL, sister-in law Louise (Rebstock) Doering of Springfield, Mo, brother-in-law James Rebstock (Linda) of Friendswood, Tx, and several nieces and nephews.
