



Lillian Borgsmiller

May 18, 1915 - September 22, 2007

Lillian Stewart Borgsmiller, age 92, of Murphysboro, passed away at the Century Assisted Living in Carbondale, at 1:15 p.m. Saturday, September 22, 2007.

Lillian was born on May 18, 1915, in Murphysboro, Illinois, to John Stewart and Elizabeth (Bellm) Stewart.

She had been a Dental Assistant for Dr. Perry and later worked as a bookkeeper for the former City National Bank in Murphysboro. Then for twenty five years, she worked in the classified advertizing department for the Southern Illinoisan.

Mrs. Borgsmiller was a member of St. Andrew Catholic Church and St. Andrew Altar Society in Murphysboro. She was a charter member of the St. Andrew Hospital Ladies Auxiliary, which is now the St. Joseph Hospital Ladies Auxiliary in Murphysboro. She was a long time volunteer for the American Red Cross. She was also a founding member of the St. Andrew's School Mother's Club, which would later become the P.T.A. at the school. She was also a member of the Delta Theta Tau Sorority.

Lillian married Charles Edward Borgsmiller on September 28, 1940, and he preceded her in death on December 18, 1974.

She is survived by one daughter and son in law Patricia "Patti" Borgsmiller Elmore and Donald Elmore of Murphysboro; and one grandson and his wife Donald Elmore Jr. and Julia Prentice of Dedham, Mass.

She was preceded in death by two sisters Amelia Marie Stewart and Margaret Stewart Burke and a brother-in-law Cassie Burke.
