September 10, 1918 - August 26, 2014

Lillie Florence Boucher, age 95 of Murphysboro, passed away Tuesday, August 26, 2014 at her daughter's home with both of her daughter's by her side.

She was born September 10, 1918 to Herman and Jennie (Ganson) Bodemuller in Opelousas, LA.

She married William Lewis Boucher on January 25, 1935. He preceded her in death on June 14, 1974.

Lillie was a member of the Nazarene Church in Murphysboro. She also was a member of the VFW Ladies Auxiliary, American Legion Auxiliary Post 127 and the Murphysboro Area Senior Citizens Club.
