Ms. Linda G. Davidson of Gold Canyon, AZ, formerly of Richmond, IL and Dongola, IL, died on April 2, 2018, shortly after 5 am at the Hospice of the Valley, Lund Home facility in Gilbert, AZ. Linda was the daughter of Paul and Imogene Davidson of Dongola, IL.

Most of Linda's teaching career took place in Richmond, IL where she taught business, accounting and computer classes for 30+ years. She retired in 2005 and moved to MountainBrook Village, Gold Canyon, AZ. Linda was a member of Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Mesa, AZ and a former member of Dongola Lutheran Church. She was an active member of the Lions Club and the local library district. She graduated from Dongola High School in 1965 and Southern Illinois University - Carbondale in 1969 with a BA degree in Business Education. She later received her Master's Degree from the University of Wisconsin – Whitewater.

Linda was an avid cat lover and is also survived by her beloved rescue cat Porters who delighted in belly rubs while upside down in her lap. During her retirement years, Linda loved to travel to foreign countries, especially Africa, where she fell in love with the big cats. Linda will be sadly missed by her family and friends.

She is survived by her sister, Carole (Edwin "Sonny") Eddleman of Anna; her
