Lucille Hughes, 87, of Cairo, passed away at 1:21pm on Wednesday, August 16, 2017 at University of Kentucky Medical Center.

Lucille was born on May 9, 1930 in Wickliffe, Kentucky, the daughter of Arthur H. and Mary Bettie (Sams) Lee. She married Raymond Hughes on February 8, 1947, in Hernando, Mississippi.

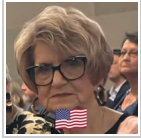
