Dr. Marc A. Stierwalt, D.P.M., 67, of Murphysboro, passed away at his home in Murphysboro, at 6:10 pm. Friday, January 22, 2010.

It was his request for his body to be donated to the School of Medicine.

Friends may call at Pettett Funeral Home in Murphysboro, on Saturday, January 30, 2010, from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. and a short memorial service will be held at 1 p.m. Saturday at the funeral home. Marc was born on October 29, 1942, in Evansville, Indiana, to Gibson H. Stierwalt and Helen M. (Funkhouser) Stierwalt.

Dr. Stierwalt practiced podiatry in Southern Illinois for almost forty years.

He loved nature and being outdoors, but he will be especially remembered for

his love for gardening and then for donating the vegetables to the local food bank.

Marc married Sharon Keller on August 17, 1968, in Ste. Marie, IL and she survives.
