Margaret Ann (Lyon) Garner, 74, of Fredericksburg, VA, formerly of Cobden, died Thursday, January 20, 2005 after a battle with cancer.

She was born January 3, 1931 in Taikyu, Korea the daughter of William and Ruth Lorene (Jones) Lyon. She married Harold Eugene Garner on September 29, 1956.

Margaret received her Undergraduate Degree in Education from the University of Dubuque, Iowa in 1952 and her Master's Degree in Education from Southern Illinois University. She contributed 37 years to education in Cumberland County, Toledo, Illinois, retiring in 1993.
