November 21, 1915 - June 26, 2007

Murphysboro's first meter maid Marguerite Hardy dies at age 91, at 4:37 p.m., Tuesday, June 26, 2007, in the Rehab and Care Center of Jackson County, in Murphysboro, Illinois.

Her last residence had been at 231 North Seventh Street. She was a life-long Murphysboro resident and member of the First Christian Church, where Marguerite served as Deaconess, Board Member, Sunday School Teacher, Bible School Teacher, Choir Member, and member of the Dorcas Class.

Mrs. Hardy had been song leader at the Hanson Street Hi-Rise, Secretary of the Brown Shoe Factory Club, and a Published Poet. She has served as a volunteer at the nursing homes and St. Joseph Memorial Hospital.

Marguerite was born on November 21, 1915, and was the daughter of Maude (Burton) Etherton and Scott Etherton.

She has one son, Edgar Jones Jr., Murphysboro, and one daughter, Joyce Farag, Marion;

four grandsons and six great grandchildren.

Two brothers, one sister, one great grandchild, and two husbands, Edgar

Jones Sr. and Thomas Hardy, preceded her in death.
