Marie Bernhardt, 95, of Murphysboro passed away at 11:15 a.m. on Thursday, October 14, 2021, at Memorial Hospital of Carbondale.

Marie was born August 10, 1926 in Chicago to Peter and Francis (Kjellstrom) Lombardo.

She married Edward C. Bernhardt on August 31, 1947, in Chicago. They celebrated fifty-one years together. She was a member of Morning Etude, the local chapter of Federated Music Clubs of America, Music

Teachers' National Association, Illinois State Music Teachers' Association and its local chapter Egyptian Chapter, Church Women United, and American Guild of Organists. She was the Member of the Year of the Illinois State Music Teachers Association in 1999 and a Junior Festival Counselor for competitions.

She was a concert pianist in her early twenties and taught many piano students in the Carbondale-Murphysboro area until she was 85.

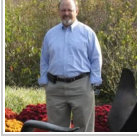
